So, chosen by God for this new life of love, dress in the wardrobe God picked out for you: compassion, kindness, humility, quiet strength, discipline. Be even-tempered, content with second place, quick to forgive an offense. Forgive as quickly and completely as the Master forgave you. And regardless of what else you put on, wear love. It's your basic, all-purpose garment. Never be without it. Let the peace of Christ keep you in tune with each other, in step with each other. None of this going off and doing your own thing. And cultivate thankfulness. Let the Word of Christ—the Message—have the run of the house. Give it plenty of room in your lives. Instruct and direct one another using good common sense. And sing, sing your hearts out to God! Let every detail in your lives—words, actions, whatever—be done in the name of the Master, Jesus, thanking God the Father every step of the way.

Behavior Guidelines

1. Be on time and present at all scheduled activities. It is your responsibility to know our itinerary and be accounted for at all times.
2. Stay with your group. This trip involves several outings where you will be expected to be with your group and group leader at all times.
3. At no time are boys to be in girls' rooms or girls to be in boys' rooms except where designated as common areas. Failure to comply may result in dismissal from the tour. Consider this your only warning.
4. Curfew - you are to be in your assigned room and lights out when indicated by the schedule. Failure to comply with curfew will result in disciplinary action. A repeat offense may result in dismissal from the tour.
5. Beds do not have to be made, but rooms should be picked up and straightened. ROOMS WILL NOT BE TRASHED!
6. Cell phones may be taken on the trip but are to be used only outside of ministry and concert activities.
7. Everyone must be in the uniform of the day at all times unless given permission to change clothes during free time. During free time, please dress in a way that will not hinder our mission. **Shorts must be no more than 2 in. above the knee.** No spaghetti straps or tank tops. If asked to change clothes, please do so promptly, respectfully and without discussion.

This trip is not a vacation for Living Proof, nor is it a reward. It is a mission effort significantly, underwritten by FBC Carrollton. Any behavior that undermines the purposes of this effort will not be tolerated. Anyone who repeatedly violates the intentions of our church will be dismissed from the tour at the expense of his/her parents. Our prayer is that this effort will not only bless the ministries we will service, but that our lives will be changed as well.

For I see a world so broken; Father, hear me pray.*

It would seem that this song should be referenced at the beginning of the trip, rather than the end. But, it is here because it is our prayer that the mission that began in our hearts a week ago will continue at home - and around the world - wherever God leads you. We may be going home today, but in a very real sense, God is always sending us somewhere. The question is whether or not we will have the faith to follow Him.
